each as follows: wit: One Hundred Dollars on Dec. 1st. 1933;  
One hundred Dollars on Dec. 1st. 1934 and One Hundred Dollars  
on Dec. 1st. 1935 with interest thereon from date

at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annual  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be due any time past  
due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose
