SEND GREETING:

Whereas, *I* the said *Haywood M<sup>c</sup> David*

in and by *My* certain *promissory note* note in writing, of even date with

these presents, *am* well and truly indebted to *Mary E. R. Eskew*

in the full and just sum of *One Hundred and fifty-five (165.00)* Dollars  
to be paid *one year from date*

with interest thereon from *date* at the rate of *8* per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid *annually*  
until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of *Twenty Dollars* besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, THAT *I* the said *Haywood M<sup>c</sup> David*  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said *Mary E. R. Eskew*  
according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of *Three Dollars*, to *me* the said *Haywood M<sup>c</sup> David*  
in hand well and truly paid by the said *Mary E. R. Eskew*

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

*Mary E. R. Eskew, her heirs and assigns forever*  
*All that piece parcel or lot of land lying and being on the east side of Green Line in the City of Greenville County and State aforesaid, being the remainder of Lot no. 7 on plat made by N. E. Dalton, Esquire, March 1930 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, said lot being more particularly described on said plat as follows, to wit:*  
*Beginning at an iron pin on the east side of Green Line corner of property belonging to Mrs. Minnie B. Stillledge and running thence along line of Mrs. Stillledge N. 88-49 E. 198 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 23-22 W. 59 feet to an iron pin; thence with the joint lines of Lots Nos. 6 and 7 in a westerly direction, approximately 17.3 feet to an iron pin; thence in a northerly direction approximately 54 feet to the beginning corner.*
