SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I the said P. A. Green

in and by my certain Promissory Note in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to John Thomas Henderson

in the full and just sum of One Hundred fifty 11 Dollars to be paid On or by the first day of January 1935

with interest thereon from date July 11, 1935 at the rate of 7 per cent. per annum, to be computed and paid annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of a reasonable amount besides all cost and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note and to be collectible as a part thereof; if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That I, P. A. Green in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said John Thomas Henderson according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me the said P. A. Green in hand well and truly paid by the said John Thomas Henderson

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

John Thomas Henderson his heirs and assigns:  
All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land lying being and situate in the County and State aforesaid and in the town of Fountain Inn on Green Avenue; Beginning on Green Avenue, corner of the W. M. Chamblee Estate lot, running west 250 feet to corner of Lot of Walter Curry or Ruth Cox Curry; thence South 180 feet; thence East 250 feet; thence North 180 feet to the beginning corner on Green Avenue. This being the same lot of land conveyed to me by deed of W. P. Meadors, which is duly recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County. Bounded by Green Avenue, Chamblee Estate, Curry Lot et al.
