WHEREAS, I, Edna J. Lockwood, the said Edna J. Lockwood,

Dollars, to be paid Six months after date

with interest thereon, from April 28th. 1933 at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid Semi-annually

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of  
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
reue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

Reasonable Disbursements besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on the said note to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will  
more fully appear.

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell  
and release unto the said

Elisabeth Martin, her heirs and assigns forever:  
All that piece, parcel, lot of land, lying, situate and  
being in Greenville Township, State and County aforesaid  
and better known and designated as lot no. 17 of Sec-  
tion A, according to plat of R.E. Dalton, Engineer, Sub-  
division known as Highland Terrace, said plat being  
recorded in R.M.C. Office for Greenville County, South  
Carolina in Plat Book "E" at Page 101, reference to which  
is craved, the said lot having a frontage of 50 feet on  
Hillcrest Drive and a depth along parallel lines of 190  
feet and being the same lot of land conveyed to me by  
Miss Jessie Craig and recorded in R.M.C. Office for Green-
