with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 10 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of  
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
reue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of ten per cent.

aforesaid, just north of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and designated  
as lot No. 17, Section A, of Highland Terrace as shown by Plat recorded in Plat Book E,  
page 101 R. M. C. office for Greenville County. This lot has a frontage of 50 feet  
on the north side of Hillcrest Drive and runs back in parallel lines a distance of  
190 feet.

This being the same lot conveyed to me by Jessie L. Craig by deed dated April
