SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, **Edna J. Lockwood**,
in and by **my** certain **promissory** note in writing, of
even date with these presents, **am** well and truly indebted to

R. G. Tilman

in the full and just sum of **Three Hundred Fifty and no/100 (\$350.00)**

Dollars, to be paid **Six months after date**

with interest thereon, from **June 12, 1933** at the rate of **7%** per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid **six months after date**

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
reue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten per cent (10%)

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will
more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, **Edna J. Lockwood**,

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said **R. G. Tilman**,

according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to **me**, the said **Edna J. Lockwood**,

in hand well and truly paid by the said **R. G. Tilman**

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell
and release unto the said **R. G. Tilman, his heirs and assigns.**

All that certain lot of land situate, lying and being in the State and County
aforesaid, just north of the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, and designated
as lot No. 17, Section A, of Highland Terrace as shown by Plat recorded in Plat Book E,
page 101 R. M. C. Office for Greenville County. This lot has a frontage of 50 feet on
the north side of Hillcreat Drive and runs back in parallel lines a distance of 190 feet.
