I, M. W. Campbell, as Trustee for M. W. Campbell, Jr., Georgia Lee Campbell, Mary Frances Campbell, Ruby Alice Campbell, and Walter Reed Campbell,

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, M. W. Campbell, as Trustee aforesaid,  
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of  
even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to

R. G. Tilman,  
in the full and just sum of One Thousand and no/100 (\$1,000.00) Dollars,  
Dollars, to be paid one year after date,

with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 7% per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid semi-annually

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of  
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may  
rue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

ten (10%) per cent. besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be  
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, as will  
more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, M. W. Campbell, as Trustee, aforesaid,  
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said

R. G. Tilman,  
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me  
M. W. Campbell, as Trustee aforesaid,

in hand well and truly paid by the said R. G. Tilman

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell  
and release unto the said R. G. Tilman, his heirs and assigns forever:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land in Greenville Township, Greenville County,  
State of South Carolina, on the north side of the Easley Bridge Road, known as part of  
lot No. 46 on plat of property of J. R. Yown made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, and recorded  
in office, of R. M. C. for said County in Plat Book     , page     , and having the  
following courses and distances according to said plat:

Beginning at an iron pin, corner of lot No. 45, and running thence with said lot  
N. 30-30 W. 384.2 feet to stake in line of Camilla Y. Looper; thence with her line S. 74-10  
W. 92-97 feet to stake; thence S. 30-30 E. 407.6 feet, more or less, to iron pin on  
Easley Bridge Road; thence with said road N. 59-30 E. 90 feet to the beginning; being  
the same lot of land conveyed by Laura Elliot White to J. H. Ward by deed dated January  
11, 1926, recorded in Book 98, page 288.

Also that other lot of land in the Township, County and State aforesaid, near the  
City of Greenville, on the Anderson Road, known as lot No. 3 on plat of property of H. B.  
Bates made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, and recorded in R. M. C. Office for said County in  
Plat Book F, page 32, said lot having a frontage on the west side of Anderson Road of  
fifty feet and a depth of one hundred seventy-five feet; reference being carved to said  
plat for a more particular description. Said lot is the same conveyed by F. B. Massingale  
to J. H. Ward, deed dated October 16, 1928, and recorded in said R. M. C. Office in Book  
143, page 323.

These being the same lots conveyed to M. W. Campbell, as Trustee aforesaid, by  
M. W. Campbell, by deed dated January 30, 1933, and recorded in Deed Book 144, page 245.

On the first lot above described (lot No. 45 Easley Bridge Road) there is situate  
a six room brick residence and this mortgage constitutes a first lien on both lots  
described above.
