with interest thereon, from date at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid annually

until paid in full all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may
reue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for an attorney's fee of

of Eliza Griffin's lot and runs thence with said alley S. 68 1/2 E. 63 1/3 feet, more or
less; thence N. 21 1/2 E. 122 feet, more or less; thence N. 68 1/2 W. 63 1/3 feet, more or
less, to a stake; thence S. 21 1/2 W. 122 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner.
