sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said Wilmington Savings & Trust Company

all that certain lot of land in the Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina

that certain lot of land on N. side of Augusta Street bounded
to me by S. O. Skelton on November 7th, 1925, in Book 106 at page 230, and by S. O. Skelton thereon
described as follows:

"All that lot of land situate on N. side of Augusta Street in
City and County of Greenville, South Carolina, beginning at a
point on N. side of Augusta Street at corner of lot 2, which
point is 95 feet from Sullivan Street and runs thence along the
line of lot 2 S. 81-35 N. 239.8 feet to point in line of lot 3; thence
along said line S. 0-23 N. 125.3 feet; thence N. 88-25 E. 75 feet to point
