Beginning at a stake 3x0m, Mountain Creek, with the land of D. V. Chapman; thence N. 84-30 St. 13.83 chains to a stone 3x; thence N. 6-15 St. 11.30 chains to a stone 3x. thence S. 84 St. 16.06 chains to 3x0m, Mountain Creek, with D. V.
