B. Gibson, Jr. as Com. for Henry A. Gibson*, all of my undivided one-half interest in and to

all that tract or lot of land in *which Springs* Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina.

Beginning at iron pin about one chain north of branch; thence N. 14 E. 9.69 chs. to stone on Mrs. P. B. Roberts' line; thence S. 84 1/4 E. 9.61 chs. to stone on John Lock's line; thence S. 34 1/2 E. 15.64 to iron pin John Lock's corner; thence N. 83 1/2 E. 15.00 chs. to stone on St. Matthews Church yard; thence S. 71 3/4 E. 7.20 chs. to point on Southern Railroad; thence with said railroad, S. 33 W. 3.38 to bend; thence S 34 W. 16.65 to a point on Railroad; thence N. 59 3/4 W. 16.63 chs. to stone at cemetery; thence N. 51 3/4 W. 20.46 to beginning corner, and containing 52.57 acres, more or less, according to survey made by J.
