On the north side of Randall St. and being part of lot # 19, Section A, Stone Land Company, as shown by Plat recorded in R. M. C. Office, Greenville County, Plat Book A, page 331. For a further description, as follows:

Beginning at an iron pin on Randall St. at the joint corner of lot # 19 and # 20 and running thence with Randall St. N. 83-13 W. 52 feet to a stake; thence N. 1-41 E. 164.5 feet, more or less, to the back line of said lot; thence S. 74-30 E. 52 feet to an iron pin corner of lot # 20; thence with said lot S. 1-41 W. 156 feet to the beginning corner.
