NOW KNOW ALL MEN, That the said Mortgagor..... in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said Mortgagee..... according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to the said Mortgagor..... in hand well and truly paid by the said Mortgagee....., at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these Presents do grant, bargain and release unto the said Mortgagee....., and.....

this Heirs and Assigns, forever, all and singular that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in.....

Greenville Township, Greenville County, State aforesaid,

Being four lots described as follows:

Lot no. 1: Lot just outside the corporate limits of the city of Greenville, on the north side of Perry Avenue, known as lot no. 52 of the sub-division of H. J. Haynsworth and Davis Furman, having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at the corner of lot no. 52 and lot sold by Davis Furman and H. J. Haynsworth to Stroup, and thence running S. 67 1/2 E. 50 feet along Perry Avenue, thence with the line of lot no. 53 a distance of 192 feet to a back street unnamed; thence along said back street 50 feet to the corner of lot no. 51, thence with the line of lot no. 51 a distance of 192 feet, more or less, to the beginning corner, less, however, a strip on Doe Street at the rear of lot above described 50 x 75 feet, formerly sold to A. H. Donaldson; the lot herein described has a frontage of 50 feet on Perry Avenue with a depth of 117 feet, being one of the same lots conveyed to M. H. Griffin by Nannie L. Phillips December 31, 1919, by deed recorded in deed Book 55, page 191, R. M. C. Office for Greenville County.

Lots nos. 2 and 3: Two lots in the Town of West Greenville, being lots nos. 50 and 51 of the Furman and Haynsworth subdivision on the north side of Perry Avenue, having together a frontage of 100 feet and running back a depth of 192 feet to Doe Street, having thereon facing Doe Street two tenant houses, being the same lots which were conveyed to me (M. H. Griffin) by B. P. Coleman by his deed dated July 21, 1920 recorded in Deed Book 71, at page 62, R. M. C. Office for said Greenville County.

Lot no. 4: That lot on west side of Hampton Avenue having a frontage of approximately 55 feet on Hampton Avenue and of 66 feet on Pine Street, having a two-story house located thereon, it being the old G. B. Ligon home, being the same lot which was conveyed to me, said M. H. Griffin by Nannie L. Phillips by deed dated December 31, 1919, recorded in the said R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Deed Book 55, Page 191.
