KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

I, Catherine Burns.

Greenville

County and State aforesaid, hereinafter called first party, whether one or more, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, First party is indebted to the Land Bank Commissioner, acting pursuant to Part 3 of the Act of Congress approved May 12, 1933, known as the Emergency Farm Mortgage Act of 1933, hereinafter called second party, as evidenced by a certain promissory note, of even date herewith, for the principal sum of

Five Hundred and no/100 (\$ **500.00**) Dollars, payable to the order of the second party,

together with interest from the date of said note on the principal sum remaining from time to time unpaid, at the rate of **Five (5%)** per centum per annum,

the first payment of interest being due and payable on the **1st** day of **November**, 193**4**, and thereafter interest being

due and payable **---** annually; said principal sum being due and payable in **Ten (10)** equal, successive, **---** annual

installments of **Fifty and no/100** (\$ **50.00**) Dollars each, and a final installment of **---**

said principal being due and payable on the **1st** day of **November**, 193**8**, and thereafter the remaining installments of

principal being due and payable **---** annually until the entire principal sum, interest and principal are paid in full; all of which are such other terms,

conditions, and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference to the said note, and to the conditions, covenants and agreements therein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of One Dollar to first party in hand well and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release in fee simple, unto second party, his successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:

All that tract or parcel of land containing five (5) acres in the Paris Mountain Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, known as the Hughes place, located on the Buncombe road, five (5) miles from Greenville and bounded on the North by lands of Milinda E. Burns; on the East by lands of Clyde W. Potts; on the South by lands of Clyde W. Potts; on the West by lands of Walter Hawkins and Buncombe Road and having the following courses and distances according to survey and plat by C. M. Furman, Jr., Surveyor, May 16, 1930.

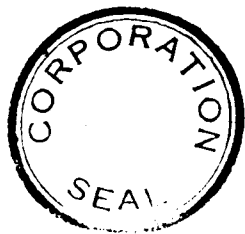
Beginning at iron pin on Buncombe Road, running thence North 73 degrees 5 minutes East 290.5 feet; thence North 68 degrees 35 minutes East 221.8 feet; thence North 61 degrees 45 minutes East 216 feet; thence North 55 degrees 35 minutes East 163 feet; thence North 66 degrees East 200 feet; thence North 14 degrees 30 minutes West 129 feet; thence South 71 degrees 30 minutes West 1045 feet; thence with the Buncombe Road South 6 degrees 45 minutes East 242 feet to beginning corner.

Copy of said plat now being on file with The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, as Agent of the Land Bank Commissioner.

The debt secured by this mortgage which is recorded in Mortgage Book 247 at Page 185, having been paid in full, Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, the owner and holder of said mortgage and of the note thereby secured pursuant to the Act of Congress known as Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation Act, by and through The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, as its agent and attorney in fact pursuant to the Act of Congress, known as Farm Credit Act of 1935, does hereby declare said mortgage satisfied and the lien thereof forever discharged.
