AMORTIZATION MORTGAGE

KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

Mrs. M. J. [unclear] of
County and State aforesaid, hereinafter called first party, whether one or more, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, First party is indebted to the Land Bank Commission acting pursuant to Part 3 of the Act of Congress approved May 12, 1933, known as the Emergency Farm Mortgage Act of 1933, hereinafter called second party, as evidenced by a certain promissory note, of even date herewith, for the principal sum of *Twelve hundred forty five and 2/3 (\$ 1245.00)* Dollars, payable to the order of the second party, together with interest from the date of said note on the principal sum remaining from time to time unpaid, at the rate of *four and 1/2%* per centum per annum, the first payment of interest being due and payable on the *1st* day of *January*, 193*4*, and thereafter interest being due and payable *annually*; said principal sum being due and payable in *100* equal successive *annual* installments of *One hundred twenty four and 1/3 (\$ 124.50)* Dollars each, and a final installment of *One hundred twenty four and 1/3 (\$ 124.50)* Dollars, the first installment of said principal being due and payable on the *1st* day of *January*, 193*4*, and thereafter the remaining installments of principal being due and payable *annually* until the entire principal sum and interest are paid in full; and which and such other terms, conditions, and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference thereto.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That first party, in consideration of the debt as evidenced by the said note, and for better securing the payment thereof to second party, according to the terms of the said note, and the performance of the conditions and covenants herein contained, and also in consideration of the sum of *One Dollar* first party in hand paid and truly paid by second party, at and before the sealing and delivery of these presents, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, has granted, bargained, sold, and released, in fee simple, and by these presents does grant, bargain, sell and release in fee simple, to second party, his successors and assigns, the following described lands, to wit:

Receiving title to the mortgage and paying thereof seven
thirty three (33) acres, more or less, known as the "Pine Place",
in Orange and Oconee Counties, Georgia, being all the land
located in Oconee County, Georgia, 3 miles north of Belmont, South
Carolina, and known as the property of Mrs. J. M. Payne, bounded
on the north by the property of Mrs. C. J. Taylor, on the east by lands of
both parties and on the west by lands of Alice Estlin Estate. Said
tracts of land are particularly described according to plat prepared
by B. F. Lightner in Oconee County, Georgia, February 1932, respectively,
the first tract containing seventy and four tenths (70.4) acres, more
or less, and described as follows: Beginning at iron pin on
Alice Estlin Estate, thence North 32 degrees West 20.75 chains to
hickory 10, thence North 56 degrees 15 minutes East 8.30 chains to
stake 310, thence North 62 degrees East 25.75 chains to
iron pin X, thence South 20 degrees East 25 chains to iron pin X,
thence North 61 degrees West 5.15 chains to S. H., thence South 74 degrees
40 minutes West 2.07 chains to X in highway, thence South 84 1/2 degrees
West 7.23 chains to point in public road, thence South 8 degrees
15 minutes West 1.00 chains to X at side of road, thence South
74 degrees 45 minutes West 2.10 chains to iron pin point of
beginning.

The second tract, containing six and nine tenths (6.9) acres, more
or less, described as follows: Beginning at the Northeast
corner of the seventy and four tenths (70.4) acre tract at iron pin,
thence North 54 degrees 15 minutes East 7.98 chains to iron pin
X02, thence North 51 degrees 30 minutes East 2.04 chains to iron
pin X12, thence South 33 degrees 30 minutes East 4 chains to
iron pin X12, thence South 15 degrees 30 minutes West 3.36
chains to pine X13, thence South 45 degrees West 8.80 chains to
iron pin, thence along the eastern boundary of the seventy and
four tenths (70.4) acre tract North 25 degrees West 8.30 chains to
point of beginning.
