AMORTIZATION MORTGAGE

KNOWN ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That

County and State aforesaid, hereinafter called first party, whether one or more, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS, first party is indebted to the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, a corporation created, organized and existing under and by virtue of an Act of Congress, entitled the Federal Farm Loan Act, hereinafter called second party, as evidenced by a certain promissory note, of even date herewith, for the principal sum of *Thirty* (\$*30,000.00*) Dollars,

payable to the order of the second party, together with interest from the date of said note on the principal sum remaining from time to time unpaid, at the rate of *Five* per centum per annum, (or at the rate of interest fixed by Act of Congress),

the first payment on interest being due and payable on the *15th* day of *November* 19*34*

and thereafter interest being due and payable *Quarterly* equal, successive, annual installments

of *One thousand seven hundred and fifty* (\$*1750.00*) Dollars, each and a final installment of (\$) Dollars, the first installment of said principal being due

and payable on the *15th* day of *November* 19*35*

and after the remaining installments of principal being due and payable annually until the entire principal sum and interest are paid in full, and each installment of principal and interest bearing interest from due date until paid at the highest rate authorized to be charged under the Federal Farm Loan Act, as amended; all of which and such other terms, conditions, and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference thereto.

The debt hereby secured is satisfied. The lien of this mortgage is satisfied. This mortgage is cancelled.

All that tract or parcel of land containing two hundred fifty-nine and one half (259 1/2) acres in the Dublin Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, known as the Scott place, located on the Horse Creek Road, ten (10) miles from Stonea Path, on the head waters of Horse Creek bounded on the north by lands of J.E. Knight; on the east by lands of Melvin Thomason and Cothran; on the south by lands of J.A. McCullough; on the west by lands of Horton, and having the following courses and distances according to survey and plat of W.M. Nash, surveyor, October 24 1912.

Beginning at a stone on in branch, running thence with the branch as a line to stone on, thence south 78 degrees east 1.90 chains to stone o.m.; thence south 78 degrees east 15.00 chains to stone o.m.; thence north 26 degrees 45 minutes east 16.00 chains to dogwood 1117 o.m.; thence north 21 degrees 30 minutes east 2.00 chains to point in road; thence north 14 degrees 30 minutes east 8.50 chains to hickory 1140 m.; thence north 65 degrees east 29.00 chains to stone o.m.; thence north 25 degrees 8 minutes west 21.15 chains to stone; thence south 82 degrees 45 minutes west 22.50 chains to stone o.m.; thence south 15 degrees 30 minutes east 3.10 chains to spring; thence south 49 degrees west 2.10 chains to R.O. 110 m.; thence north 31 degrees west 4.65 chains to stone; thence south 82 degrees 45 minutes west 58.50 chains to stone; thence south 4 degrees 15 minutes west 10.73 chains to stone; thence south 81 degrees 30 minutes east 13.95 chains to stone o.m. in branch; beginning corner.
