annually until the entire principal sum and interest are paid in full, and each installment of principal and interest bearing interest from due date until paid at the highest rate authorized to be charged under the Federal Farm Loan Act, as amended; all of which and such other terms, conditions, and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference thereto.

Good line North 33 degrees 46 minutes East 1320 feet to pipe; thence South 3 degrees 52 minutes West 169 feet to pipe and stone; thence South 4 degrees 35 minutes West 1935 feet to stone by Walnut Stump; thence South 88 degrees 33 minutes East 1224 feet to stone; thence North 4 degrees 27 minutes East 1709.7 feet to stone; thence North 78 degrees 06 minutes West 1232 feet to pipe and stone; thence North 3 degrees 52 minutes East 624 feet to pin; thence North 47 degrees 15 minutes East 673 feet to iron pin; thence South 78 degrees East 3203 feet to pipe on Greenville-Piedmont Road, beginning corner.
