payable to the order of the second party, together with interest from the date of said note on the principal sum remaining from time to time unpaid, at the rate of Five (5%) per centum per annum, (or at the rate of interest fixed by Act of Congress),

the first payment on interest being due and payable on the First day of December 1934

and thereafter interest being due and payable Twenty (20) equal, successive, annual installments

of Forty Five and no/100 (\$45.00) Dollars, each and a final installment of no/100 (\$0.00) Dollars, the first installment of said principal being due

payable on the First day of December 1934

and thereafter the remaining installments of principal being due and payable annually until the entire principal sum and interest are paid in full, and each installment of principal and interest bearing interest from due date until paid at the highest rate authorized to be charged under the Federal Farm Loan Act, as amended, all of which and such other terms, conditions, and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference thereto.

All that certain tract or parcel of land containing Thirty Seven and Ten One Hundredths (37.10) acres, or less, in Butler Township of Greenville County, South Carolina, known as part of the V. Perry Hudson estate, located on the Mauldin Road 5 miles from Greenville, South Carolina, on waters of Laurel Creek, bounded on the north by lands of the Hunt Estate, on the east by lands of M.P. Conyers, on the south by lands of Lucy L. Hindman, on the west by the Mauldin Road and lands of Lucy L. Hindman and being more particularly described according to a plat prepared by H. J.
