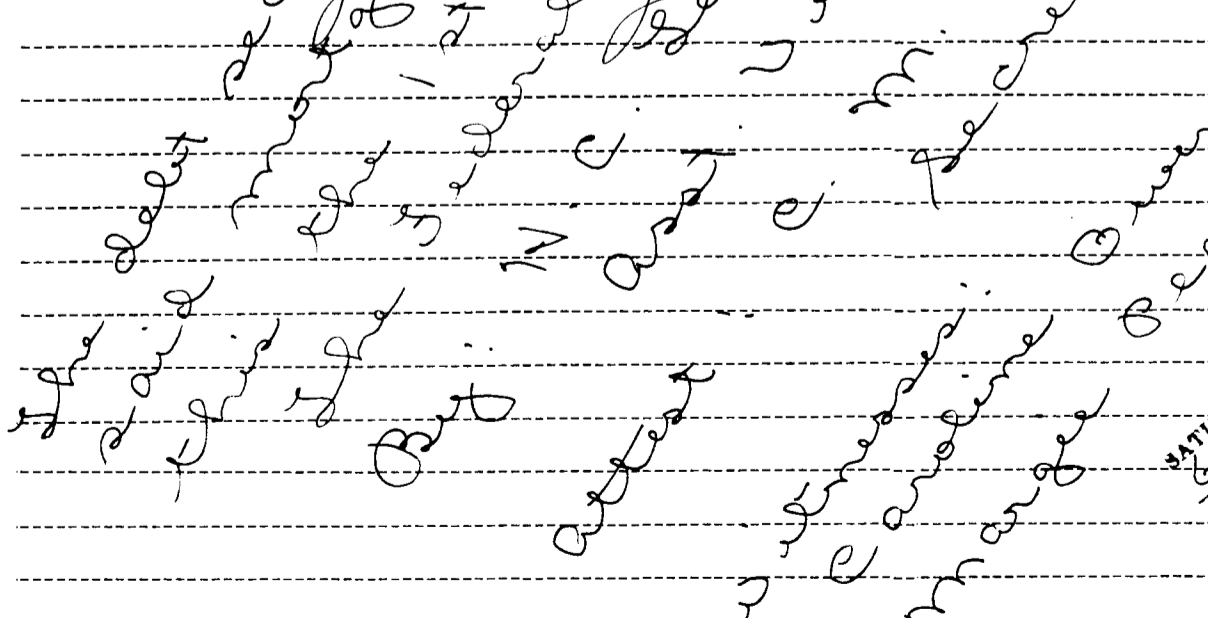

and thereafter the remaining installments of principal being due and payable annually until the entire principal sum and interest are paid in full, and each installment of principal and interest bearing interest from due date until paid at the highest rate authorized to be charged under the Federal Farm Loan Act, as amended; all of which and such other terms, conditions, and agreements as are contained in the said note, will more fully appear by reference thereto.

All that tract of land containing *One Hundred Fourteen and ⁹³/₁₀₀ (114.07)* acres in *Butler Township, Greenville County, South Carolina*, known as the *Hudson Place*, situate on the *Hudson Road* about *5 1/2* miles from *Greenville Court House*, and waters of *Brushy Creek*, waters of *Enoree River*, bounded on the north by lands of *John Rogers*, on the east by lands of *Cyrille Braslett* and *Major Walsby*; by the west by lands of *Tom Galden*, and having the following courses and distances according to survey and plat of *J.
