Whereas, by a certain <sup>Designation</sup> Deed of Trust, dated December 1st, 1931 and recorded the 13th day of February, 1932 in Book 183, Page 286, in the Office of the Register of Deeds, Greenville County, South Carolina, Lewis Barber conveyed to Edgar J.
