

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 186819-3

WHEREAS, There now remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by Saint Andrews Mission to _____

The Prudential Life Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, dated September 10th, 1936, recorded in said County on Sept. 10th, 1936, in Volume 171 of Mortgages on Page 52, the sum of One thousand (\$1,000.00) Dollars, with interest from September 10th, 1936, and,

WHEREAS, Title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in Saint Andrews Mission subject to said mortgage, and,

WHEREAS, The said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, The said Saint Andrews Mission

hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows: The sum of \$100.00 to be paid on principal on March 10th, 1937, and \$100.00 on the 10th day of each September and March thereafter up to and including the 10th day of March, 1941, and then the balance of the principal remaining unpaid on the 10th day of September, 1941.

with interest thereon from September 10th, 1936, to September 10th, 1941, at the rate of 5 1/4% per cent. per annum, payable semi- annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

Privilege is given to make payments of \$100.00, or any multiple thereof, on the principal sum remaining due on said note or any interest due date.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
