

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 210749-5

WHEREAS, There now remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by O. Mills Goodlett

to The Prudential Life Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, South Carolina, dated May 17, 1937, recorded in said County on May 17, 1937

in Volume 172 of mortgages on Page 35, the sum of Thirty-two hundred (\$3200.00) Dollars, with interest from May 17, 1937, and,

WHEREAS, Title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in O. Mills Goodlett

subject to said mortgage, and,

WHEREAS, The said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, The said O. Mills Goodlett

hereby agree to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows:

The sum of \$50.00 to be paid on the 17th of August, 1937, and the sum of \$50.00 on the 17th of November, February, May and August of each year thereafter up to and including the 17th of February, 1947, then the balance of the principal remaining unpaid on the 17th of May, 1947.

with interest thereon from May 17, 1937, to May 17, 1947, at the rate of five and one-half per cent per annum, on the 17th of Aug., Nov., Feb. and May of each year payable quarterly; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

Privilege is given the maker of said note to make additional payments of \$100.00 or any multiples thereof on the principal sum remaining due on said note on any interest due date, provided that at least ninety days prior to such date, notice shall have been given in writing to the holder thereof of the intention to make such principal payment.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.
