

AGREEMENT FOR EXTENSION OF LOAN NO. 212549-6

WHEREAS, There now remains unpaid on a certain note executed and delivered by First Baptist Church of Greenville, S.C.

to _____
The Prudential Life Insurance Company of America, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County,

South Carolina, dated June 20, 1937, recorded in said County on June 20, 1937, in Volume 194 of mortgages on Page 195, the sum of Eight Thousand eight (\$8,008.00) Dollars, with interest from June 20, 1937, and,

WHEREAS, Title to the mortgaged premises is now vested in First Baptist Church of Greenville, S.C.

subject to said mortgage, and,

WHEREAS, The said Insurance Company has been requested to make said note payable as hereinafter agreed, which it has consented to do in consideration of the payments to be made as herein provided.

NOW, THEREFORE, The said First Baptist Church of Greenville, S.C.

hereby agree S to pay the principal sum remaining due as aforesaid as follows: The sum of \$1,008.00 to be paid on the principal on the 20th day of September, 1937, and the sum of \$168.00 on the 20th day of December, March, June and September of each year thereafter up to and including the 20th day of March, 1947, then the balance of the principal remaining unpaid on the 20th day of June, 1947,

with interest thereon from June 20, 1937, to June 20, 1947, at the rate of five per cent. per annum, on the 20th day of Sept. and December, March and June of each year payable quarterly; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

PREPAYMENT PRIVILEGE:

Privilege is given to the maker of said note to make additional payments of \$100.00 or any multiples thereof on the principal sum remaining due on said note on any interest due date, provided that at least ninety days prior to such date, notice shall have been given in writing to the holder thereof of his intention to make such principal payment.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to said extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.

IN WITNESS WHEREOF, The said First Baptist Church of Greenville, S.C. by virtue of authority contained in a resolution passed at a regular meeting of its members held on June 13, 1937, has caused this Extension Agreement to be signed in its name and sealed with its seal by the Chairman of the Finance Committee and the Treasurer of said church at Greenville, S.C. this 17 day of June, 1937.

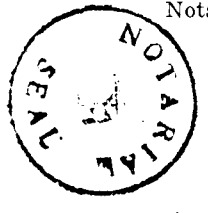
