Be it remembered, that on this 22nd day of June 1834, at the County of Raleigh, North Carolina, the said Atlantic Joint Stock Bank of Raleigh, North Carolina, did hereby transfer, sell and assign to the Federal Bank of Washington, of Washington, District of Columbia, for itself and its assigns, all and singular, its and rights, title and interest in and to that certain and attached note and mortgage book from Thos. Simmons, to-wit: dated the 11th day of July, in the original sum of \$3,000.00 said mortgage being recorded in book 178 at page 20 in the office of the Clerk of Court for Greenville County, South Carolina, and covering one tract of land in Butler Township, said County and State.

In witness whereof, the said Atlantic Joint Stock Bank of Raleigh has caused its name to be signed, written up its Vice-President and attested by its Assistant Secretary, and its corporate seal affixed thereto, all by order of its Board of Directors, this 22nd day of June 1834, and in the one hundred and fifty-eighth year of the Sovereignty and Independence of the United States of America.
