

State of South Carolina

The debt due South Carolina Historical Society by Alice Thompson Bryant and Benjamin F. Bryant on their note for Ten Thousand Dollars payable, November 5th, 1929 together with interest at the rate of seven per cent per annum, made and delivered to Alister S. Furman and by him assigned to South Carolina Historical Society, unpaid from the fifth day of November, 1932 and the taxes for the year 1933 paid by South Carolina Historical Society to preserve the title of the certain mortgage given to secure the payment of the note of even date with said note, that is to say November 5th, 1926, recorded in Mortgage Book 184 at page 111 of the official records of Greenville County, State of South Carolina and duly assigned to said South Carolina Historical Society and the subsequent supplemental mortgage given by the debtors said Alice Thompson Bryant and Benjamin F. Bryant of date December 17th, 1930 and recorded in Mortgage Book 225 page 86 of the official records of Greenville County, said debt totaling Eleven Thousand Three Hundred and Fifty Dollars, having been paid in full by the uncollected proffer of a deed of conveyance in fee simple of all the real estate covered by the lien of said mortgages and said offer having been accepted by the creditor the said South Carolina Historical Society, so full payment of such indebtedness, the said South Carolina Historical Society hereby declares the said mortgages fully satisfied and discharged.
