

Assignment

For Value Received, State Planters Bank and Trust Co., the owner and holder of a certain mortgage executed by R. D. Wain, dated the 1st day of March, 1928, and recorded in the office of the Register of Deeds, County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, in book 154, page 587 on the 2nd day of April, 1928, does hereby transfer, assign and convey to Richmond Mortgage & Loan Warehouse Company of the second part, its successors and assigns, the said mortgage, together with the debt secured thereby and the said State Planters Bank and Trust Co. hereby grants, bargains, sells and conveys unto said party of the second part, its successors and assigns, all of the right, title and interest in and to the lands described in said mortgage, and hereby assigns all of the powers conferred upon it in said mortgage;

And the said State Planters Bank and Trust Co. hereby covenants, promises and agrees to and with said party of the second part that a sum is now due and owing upon the said mortgage and the debt secured thereby the sum of Two Thousand Eighty + no/100 Dollars (\$2080.00) principal, together with interest thereon from the 1st day of March, 1933, at the rate of 6 per cent per annum until maturity and with interest at the rate of 8 per cent per annum on each installment after maturity. 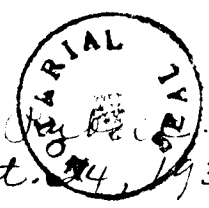
