in the full and just sum of (\$100.00) One hundred dollars,  
Dollars, to be paid Dec. 1st, 1935.

with interest thereon, from maturity at the rate of 8 per cent. per annum to be  
computed and paid annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any portion of  
principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder thereof, who may  
sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10%

added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection of said debt, or any part thereof,  
be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note, reference being thereunto had, will

and release unto the said B. D. Henson.

and State of S. C. adjoining lands of M. T. Henson, Lewis Henson Est. and Mrs. Jim  
Sudduth, containing 29 acres, more or less, and being the same tract of land deeded to  
me by my mother Nancy E. Henson, the 9 day August 1887.
