Know all men by these Presents, that the undersigned, Atlantic Life Insurance Company, a corporation organized and existing under the laws of the State of Virginia, the holder and owner of a certain mortgage from Annie M. Jenkins, of the County of Greenville, State of South Carolina, to the said Atlantic Life Insurance Company, dated November 10, 1925, and recorded in the Office of R. M. It is intended by these presents to assign the three last maturing principal notes and the last maturing interest note described in and secured by said mortgage, subject to the credits aforesaid, and with interest on said principal notes paid to September 7, 1935, all other notes, both principal and interest, secured by said mortgage having been paid and marked "Paid".
