Know All Men By These Presents, that for and in consideration of the sum of Five Thousand (\$5000.00) Dollars, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, the owner and holder of the mortgage hereinafter referred to and of the note thereby secured, does hereby, subject to the conditions hereinafter stated, release and forever discharge from the lien of that certain mortgage from Hanny C. Haroley to the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, securing the payment of the principal sum of Ninety-two Hundred (\$9200.00) dated the 13th day of April, 1934, and recorded in the office of the C.C.C.P. and G.S. and/or R.M.C. for Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Mortgage Book 247, at page 129, the property hereinafter described; and that for and in consideration of the sum of One (\$1.00) Dollar, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, the owner and holder of the mortgage hereinafter referred to and of the note thereby secured pursuant to the Act of Congress known as Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation Act approved January 31, 1934, by and through the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, as its Agent and Attorney in fact pursuant to the Act of Congress known as Farm Credit Act of 1935 approved June 3, 1935, does hereby, subject to the conditions hereinafter stated, release and forever discharge from the lien of that certain mortgage executed and delivered by Hanny C. Haroley, to the Land Bank Commissioner, dated the 13th day of April, 1934, and recorded in the office of the C.C.C.P. and G.S. and/or R.M.C. for Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Mortgage Book 250, at page 121, the property hereinafter described, to-wit:

All that tract or parcel of land containing 18.46 acres in Butler Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina located on the Woods Crossing Road and Lowndes Hill Road, about three miles northeast of the city of Greenville and shown by a plat made by Dalton and Neves, Engrs. on July 19, 1926, said plat having been revised May, 1936, to show the new location of the Lowndes Hill Road and the Woods Crossing Road, and having according to said plat the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at a point in the center of the intersection of the new location of the Lowndes Hill Road and the new location of the Woods Crossing Road, and running thence along new location of Woods Crossing Road North 80 degrees 55 minutes East 829 feet to iron pin in said road at corner of lands now or formerly owned by Nickliffe; thence along line of said lands North 12 degrees 30 minutes East 582 feet to an iron pin; thence North 89 degrees 16 minutes East 132 feet to an iron pin; thence along lands now or formerly owned by Sullivan North 12 degrees 45 minutes East 72 feet to iron pin; thence North 45 degrees 00 minutes West 927 feet to an iron pin in the center of the Lowndes
