

Know All, Men By These Presents:

That Walter A. Williams, Jr. of the City of Richmond Virginia holder of a certain mortgage given by Mortgage Corporation of Virginia to Walter A. Has received full payment of said indebtedness, and hereby declares said obligation and indebtedness fully paid and the lien of the mortgage securing the same forever discharged and ended, and does hereby authorize the Clerk of Court for Greenville County to enter upon the records of said mortgage full satisfaction thereof.
