

State of South Carolina } Partial Release of mortgage Lien.
County of Greenville } (Bank Loan no. 7 C 7 8 9)

Know all men by these Presents, that for and in consideration of the sum of Four Hundred (\$400.00) Dollars, receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, the owner and holder of the mortgage herein-after referred to and of the note thereby secured, does hereby, subject to the conditions hereinafter stated, release and forever discharge from the lien of that certain mortgage from Blough C. Wood to The First Carolina Joint Stock Land Bank, securing the payment of the principal sum of Sixty-two Hundred (\$6200.00) Dollars, dated the 12th day of November, 1926, and recorded in the office of the C. C. C. P. & S. S. and / or R. M. C. for Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in mortgage Book 181, at Page 210, the following described property, to-wit:

All that tract of land containing three (3) acres, more or less in South Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, being tract number 7 on plat made by W. A. Ellis Surveyor, dated July 8, 1936, and more fully described therein as follows:

Begin at a point on West side of the Greenville Piedmont road and run north 88 degrees West 555 feet to the C. & S. Railroad; thence along the railroad South 43 degrees West 265.5 feet to a corner; thence South 88 degrees East 682 feet to said highway; thence up the highway North 14 degrees 30 minutes East 210 feet to the point of beginning.

Provided, However, that the security of The Federal Land Bank of Columbia as described and the aforesaid mortgage shall, in all respects, except as to the premises herein before described, be preserved and protected and that the lien of said mortgage, except as hereby released and discharged shall remain in full force and effect and the terms, conditions and covenants of said mortgage, and of the note, thereby secured, shall remain unchanged. This release is subject to the consent of any other lienholders.

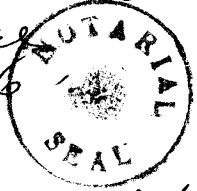
