TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

WHEREAS, I the said A. O. Barbara

SEND GREETING:

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, and well and truly indebted to AMERICAN BUILDING AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C. in the full and just sum of One Thousand, Two Hundred

and no/100 (1,200.00) Dollars, with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of Twelve and no/100 (12.00)

Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid; said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failing to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said A. O. Barbara

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, for the said A. O. Barbara

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

and in Greenville Township, being known and designated as Lots Nos. 39 and 40 of a subdivision known as "Junction Heights," and having in the aggregate, according to plat thereof recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County in Plat Book C, Page 106, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Parker Road, joint corner of Lots 38 and 39, which point is 100 feet west from the north-west intersection of Parker Road and Center street, and running thence along said Parker Road, N. 37-06 W. 100 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots 40 and 41, which point is 100 feet east from the northeast intersection of Parker Road and Power street; thence along the line of Lot 41, N. 62-30 E. 150 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 37-06 E. 100 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 62-30 W. 150 feet to the beginning corner. Being the same lots conveyed to me by Carolina Loan & Trust Company by deed dated July 18, 1936, not yet recorded, this mortgage being given to secure a portion of the purchase price thereof."
