Heirs and Assigns, forever, all and singular that certain piece, parcel, lot or tract of land situate, lying and being in Greenville County, State aforesaid,

on the Old Augusta Road and having the following metes and bounds according to a plat made by J. Riddell March 27, 1936, to wit:

Beginning at an iron pin in the intersection of the Old Augusta Road and another road and running with Old Augusta Road, N. 37-55 W. 408.5 feet; thence S. 84-25 W. 108 feet to a stake; thence S. 17-35 W. 1362 to old creek run; thence with said old creek run, S. 72-15 E. 40 feet; thence S. 84-45 E. 200 feet to a stake; thence N. 8-00 W. 108 feet; thence N. 14-35 E. 103 feet to a stake in Brushy Creek; thence N. 17-35 E. 830 feet to an iron pin in oak stump on old road. thence with said road N. 84-00 E. 312 feet to the beginning corner, and containing eight acres, more or less; said property being that conveyed to Broaderus Mason by John J.
