(\$ 100.00) Dollars, to be paid one year from date

with interest thereon from late July 1931 at the rate of 6 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid

interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including the reasonable and necessary expenses as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

Beginning at corner of Bailey Street known and designated as estate of Moss Moon, and running West along said Moon line 75 feet, 8 inches to corner of some property thence South along Goin's line 46 feet, 6 inches to corner of Mal C. Washington's line, thence East along Mal C. Washington's to corner on Bailey Street, thence North along Bailey Street 37 feet, to the beginning corner, being a portion of a lot conveyed to Mae C. Washington by E. Suman, known and designated as Lot no. 30 as shown by plat made by M. A. Wilson.
