Whereas, the late William Gordon McCabe of Petersburg, Virginia, under clause 11 (2) of his will established a trust fund, the income therefrom being payable to Frances Claiborne McCabe and William Gordon McCabe, Jr. or the survivor for life, and upon the death of both of these parties, the principal to be paid to William Gordon McCabe III and Edmund Osborne McCabe II, share and share alike, and the trust dissolved, and

Whereas, William Gordon McCabe, Jr., Edward Raynesford Warner McCabe, and Petersburg Savings and American Trust Company of Petersburg, Virginia were the only qualified and acting executors and trustees under the will of William Gordon McCabe, the Petersburg Savings and American Trust Company having subsequently resigned and been discharged as executors and trustee, and

Whereas, an action was brought in the Chancery Court of the City of Richmond, Virginia which resulted in a decree dissolving the trust and directing that the assets of the trust estate be turned over to William Gordon McCabe III and Edmund Osborne McCabe II, subject to a life estate in their parents, William Gordon McCabe, Jr. and Frances Claiborne McCabe, and the survivor, which decree is duly entered of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County S. C. in Deed Book 296 at page 220, and

Whereas, Frances Claiborne McCabe is now deceased, leaving as the only parties in interest in the assets of the original trust estate, William Gordon McCabe, Jr. and his sons William Gordon McCabe III and Edmund Osborne McCabe II, and

Whereas, William Gordon McCabe III executed and delivered to William Gordon McCabe, Jr., Edward Raynesford Warner McCabe, and Petersburg Savings and American Trust Company of Petersburg, Virginia, as executors and trustees under the will of William Gordon McCabe, his note and real estate Mortgage covering a lot of land in Greenville County Greenville Township, S. C. dated June 21, 1937 in the principal sum of \$7000.00, said mortgage being duly entered of record in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Mortgage Book 268 at page 246 and now being a part of the assets of the original trust estate now in the hands of William Gordon McCabe III and Edmund Osborne McCabe II,

Now Therefore, we, William Gordon McCabe, Jr., William Gordon McCabe III and Edmund Osborne McCabe II, the owners and holders of the above described mortgage and the only persons having any interest therein, do hereby acknowledge payment of said mortgage in full and the application of the funds received in payment thereof to the assets of the fund established under the will of William Gordon McCabe, and we do hereby empower Ollie M. Farnsworth, Register of Mesne Conveyances for Greenville County, S. C. to enter satisfaction of the same upon the records of her office.
