Know All Men By These Presents, that for value received, The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, the owner and holder of the security instrument hereinafter referred to and end of the note thereby secured, does, subject to the conditions hereinafter stated, hereby release and forever discharge from the liens of that certain security instrument, from B. J. Edwards, to the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, securing the payment of the principal sum of Twelve Hundred (\$1200.00) Dollars, dated the 31 day of October, 1944, and recorded in the public records for Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Mortgage Book 252, at page 270, the property hereinafter described, and Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation, the owner and holder of the security instrument hereinafter referred to and of the note thereby secured, pursuant to the Act of Congress known as Federal Farm Mortgage Corporation Act (Sec. 1020 b, Title 12, U. S. C.) by and through the Federal Land Bank of Columbia, as its Agent and Attorney in fact pursuant to the Act of Congress known as Farm Credit Act of 1935 (Sec. 1016 h, Title 12, U. S. C.) does subject to the conditions hereinafter stated hereby release and forever discharge from the lien of that certain security instrument, executed and delivered by B. J. Edwards, the Land Bank Commissioner, securing the payment of the principal sum of Thirteen Hundred Dollars (\$1300.00) dated the 31 day of October, 1944, and recorded in the public records for Greenville County, State of South Carolina, in Mortgage Book 330, at page 140 the property hereinafter described, to-wit:

All that certain parcel or tract of land containing Twenty Four and five-tenths (24.5) acres, more or less, in Bates Township, Greenville County, South Carolina, more fully described as follows: Begin at the center of the bridge where the Old Buncombe Highway crosses Hillhouse Creek and run along said highway South 3 degrees 30 minutes East 207.5 feet; thence South 76 degrees 30 minutes West 422.2 feet to said creek; thence along the creek; thence along the creek South 15 degrees West 233 feet, South 75 degrees West 72.6
