TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

Me, L. N. Buckner and Nettie E. Buckner of Greenville County, S. C.  
WHEREAS, we the said L. N. Buckner and Nettie E. Buckner

in and by us certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, we well and truly indebted to FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of Eighteen hundred and no/100

(\$1800.00) Dollars,  
with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of Eighteen Dollars

(\$18.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid; said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we, the said L. N. Buckner and Nettie E. Buckner

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to

the said L. N. Buckner and Nettie E. Buckner in hand well and truly paid by the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Greenville Township, next the corporate limits of the City of Greenville, on the south side of the Sullivan Road, and being more or less and designated as Lot No. 55 of Glenn Grove Park, as shown on a plat of said subdivision made by P. E. Dalton, C. E. on May 14, 1924, said plat being recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book 5 at Page 229, having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds and courses and distances, to-wit:  
Beginning at an iron pin in the southwest corner of Sullivan Road and Lincoln Road, and running thence with the line of Sullivan Road, N. 75 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 56; thence with the line of said lot, S. 54 W. 104.5 feet to an iron pin in line of Lot No. 54; thence with the line of said lot, S. 74-12 E. 50 feet to an iron pin in line of Lincoln Road; thence along Lincoln Road, N. 5-48 E. 163.4 feet to the beginning corner, said premises being that conveyed to L. N. Buckner and Nettie E. Buckner by Willie Mae Speer, by deed dated February 13, 1937, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book 4 of Series 193 at Page 229.
