with interest thereon from Date at the rate of 7 per centum per annum, to be computed and paid

Semi-Annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

All that piece tract of land in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing 46.76 acres, more or less, according to Survey by W. J. Riddle January 1937, and revised February 12, 1937, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at a stake in line of Mrs. Floyd Massey and running thence N. 18-20 W. 760 feet to a stake; thence N. 5-05 W. 501.5 feet to iron pipe in Cooper line; thence with Cooper line N. 60-10 W. 1728 feet to stone; thence continuing with Cooper S. 79-50 W. 363 feet to stake on bank of lake; thence continuing the same direction 150 feet to bank of Saluda River; thence down the river approximately 500 feet to line of Elrod property. Traverse line from stake on bank of lake, which point is 363 feet from the stone corner, along the edge of lake as follows: S. 12-30 E. 130 feet to bend; S. 4-33 E. 88 feet to bend; S. 7-30 W/ 84 feet to bend; S. 19-0 E. 223 feet to stake on bend of lake; S. 70-0 E. 142 feet along Elrod line to stake; thence along line of Taylor S. 41-50 E. 1524 feet to a stone; thence continuing with Taylor property S. 60-0 E. 430 feet to an iron pin in a branch, corner of Mrs. Massey property, and thence along line of Mrs. Massey S. 68-25 E. 582 feet to the beginning corner, together with the right to the use of 30 feet of road over other land of the Grantor along property of Mrs. Floyd Massey and leading towards the National Highway.

Upon which is being constructed a five-room dwelling house, same having been framed and hulled in.
