We, Luther Alexander and Pearl F. Alexander

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said Luther Alexander and Pearl F. Alexander

in and by our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, are well and truly indebted to FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of One Thousand one Hundred Fifty

(\$1,150.00) Dollars,

with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of Twelve and No/100

(\$ 12.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid, and monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note shall at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or in legal proceedings of any kind.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we the said Luther Alexander and Pearl F. Alexander

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to us

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

Being all of Lot No. 119 and part of Lot No. 119-A in Block A of a Plat of City View, recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book A, page 460 and 461, and having the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

BEGINNING at a stake on the East side of Hunt Street, 196 feet South of line of Monaghan Mills property, at corner of Lot No. 120, and running thence S. 10 W. 50 feet to stake, corner of Lot No. 119; thence in an easterly direction with line of said lot 115 feet, more or less, to stake; thence in a Northerly direction 50 feet to stake in line of Lot No. 120; thence in a westerly direction with line of said lot 110 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

This is the same lot of land conveyed to us by the mortgagee by deed of even date, yet to be recorded, and the within mortgage is given to secure the balance due on the purchase price.
