M. C. Office for Greenville County, in Plat Book H, at page 253, and having, according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin on the west side of Barrett Street, joint corner of Lots Nos. 23 and 24, and running thence along the west side of Barrett Street, N. 28-05 E. 50 feet to an iron pin, joint corner of Lots Nos. 24 and 25; thence along the joint line of said lots, N. 66-12 W. 135.2 feet to an iron pin in rear line of Lot No. 29, which point is also the joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 24 and 25; thence S. 31-44 W. 50.35 feet to an iron pin in rear line of Lot No. 30, joint rear corner of Lots Nos. 23 and 24; thence along the joint line of said Lots Nos. 23 and 24, S. 66-12 E. 138.5 feet to the point of beginning.
