Agreement for Exrention of Loan No. 32493

WHEREAS, there remains unpaid on a certain note executed by Dr. E. W. Carpenter to The Penn Mutual Life Insurance Company of Philadelphia, secured by a mortgage upon real estate in Greenville County, State of South Carolina, dated October 2, 1922 and recorded in said County on November 1, 1922, in Volume 126 of Mortgages, Page 6 the sum of Seventy-seven Hundred and Fifty Dollars, with interest from September 1, 1937; and

Carpenter and E. W. Carpenter, Jr., Trustees hereby agree, jointly and severally, to pay the principal sum remaining due, as aforesaid, as follows:

\$250.00 semi-annually, commencing March 1, 1938, with the balance payable on September 1942, with the privilege of paying not more than 20% of the balance remaining due on any interest paying date, without bonus., with interest thereon from September 1, 1937 until said principal shall be fully paid, at the rate of five per cent. per annum, payable semi-annually; and with interest after maturity as set forth in said note.

And the parties to this agreement hereby consent to the above extension and agree that said mortgage shall continue a first lien upon said premises, and that said note and mortgage and all their covenants and conditions shall remain in force except as herein modified.

IT IS AGREED that the Statute of Limitaions shall not begin to run against the note or said mortgage before the end of said extended period.
