All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land with the buildings and improvements thereon, situate on the East side of Harcourt and being known and designated as Lot No. 4 as shown on plat of property of J. Ed. Hart, made by R. E. Dalton, Engineer, February, 1925, and having, according to said plat, which is recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County S. C. in Plat Book F, at page 284, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:-

BEGINNING at an iron pin in the Eastern line of Harcourt, joint corner of lots 4 and 5, and running thence with the line of lot 5, S. 75-07 E. 113.1 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 53-13 E. 52.5 feet to an iron pin in the Western line of Elford Street; thence with Elford Street S. 47-50 W. 118.2 feet to an iron pin, and continuing in line with Elford Street S. 46-36 W. 145.5 feet to an iron pin at corner of lot #3; thence with the line of lot #3, N. 5-20 W. 189.3 feet to an iron pin in the Eastern line of Harcourt; thence along the curved line of Harcourt, the course of which is N. 50-23 E. 76.5 feet to the point of beginning.
