We, Clyde South and Lucile Robinson South

SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, we the said Clyde South and Lucile Robinson South

in and by our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, are and truly indebted to FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of Two Thousand, Five Hundred and No/100

(\$ 2,500.00) Dollars,

with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of Twenty-Five and No/100

(\$ 25.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid; said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for attorney's fee, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That we the said Clyde South and Lucile Robinson South

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to us

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. "BEGINNING at an iron pin on Washington Road, corner of Lot No. 39, and running thence with line of said road, N. 86-30 E. 50 feet to an iron pin, corner of Lot No. 41; thence with the line of Lot 41 S. 17-30 E. 175 feet to an iron pin on Boyce Spring avenue; thence with said avenue, S. 86-30 W. 50 feet to an iron pin, rear corner of Lot 39; thence with the line of Lot No. 39, N. 17-30 W. 175 feet to the beginning corner, and being one of the lots conveyed to Arthur L. Teal by deed dated Jan 11, 1936 and recorded in the R. M. C. office for Greenville County, in Vol. 180, page 378."
