WHEREAS, I, Harold Few, the said Harold Few
in and by a certain promissory (real estate) note in writing, of
even date with these presents, I am well and truly indebted to George W. Few

in the full and just sum of Four Hundred Sixty-five and no/100
Dollars, to be paid annually

with interest thereon, from Date (Feb. 21, 1938) at the rate of 6 per cent. per annum to be
computed and paid X

until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at the same rate as principal; and if any
portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of
the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of X

besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be
added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt,
or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by the said note,
reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said Harold Few
in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said George W. Few
according to the terms of the said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars, to me, the said Harold Few
in hand well and truly paid by the said George W. Few

at and before the signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold, and released, and by these Presents do grant,
bargain, sell and release unto the said George W. Few

All that certain piece parcel or plat of land and being all of tract # 5 according to plat
of D. W., B. F. and E. E. Reese property, made by H. S. Brockman, Surveyor, on Dec. 2, 1928,
and having the following metes and bounds- Beginning at an iron pin in the center of Few's
bridge road, corner of tracts # 1 and # 5, and running thence along center of said road, S.
76-45 W. 100' to bend in said road; thence along center of said road S. 68 W. 300' to bend
in road; thence along center of road S. 57 W. 100' to another bend in road; thence S. 46 W.
500' to another bend in road; thence S. 51 W. 100' to slight bend in road corner of tracts
one and # two. Thence S. 72 W. 100' to bend in road; thence along center of said road
S. 84-15 W. 95' to point in road on old Few's cemetery line; thence along cemetery line S.
22 E. 122' to center of old road on Ignacius Few line; thence N. 62-50 E. 63' to iron pin on
Few line; thence S. 85-51 E. 1274' to an iron pin on Ephraim Few Branch; thence N. 17-52 W.
843.5' along A. B. Cannon line to an iron pin in center of Few's bridge road. This being
the beginning corner and containing 15 acres more or less.

Also all of Tract # 4 having the following metes and bounds beginning at a point in the
center of the Few's bridge road on line of Few's cemetery. Thence down center of Few's bridge
road in S. Westerly direction to point in road at Few's Bridge across South Tiger River.
Thence down river to stake in old road on I. F. Few's line; thence up center old road to stake
in old road, which is corner of old Few Cemetery. Thence along line of old Few Cemetery
N. 24 W. 202.5' to the center of Few's Bridge road, which is the beginning corner and contains
eighteen and four tenths (18.4) more or less. This being land conveyed to me by George W. Few,
