SEND GREETING:

Whereas, I the said L. F. Simpson, Jr.
in and by my certain promissory note in writing, of even date with these presents, am
well and truly indebted to Jas. F. Davenport

in the full and just sum of Five hundred dollars
(\$) Dollars, to be paid May 1, 1939

with interest thereon from date at the rate of six per centum per annum, to be computed and paid

annually until paid in full; all interest not paid when due to bear interest at same rate as principal; and if any portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, and in case said note, after its maturity, should be placed in the hands of an attorney for suit or collection, or if before its maturity it should be deemed by the holder thereof necessary for the protection of his interests to place and the holder should place the said note or this mortgage in the hands of an attorney for any legal proceedings, then and in either of said cases the mortgagor promises to pay all costs and expenses including 10 per cent. of the indebtedness as attorneys' fees, this to be added to the mortgage indebtedness, and to be secured under this mortgage as a part of said debt.

at and before signing of these Presents, the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have granted, bargained, sold and released and by these Presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said

Jas. F. Davenport, his heirs and assigns:

All that piece, parcel or lot of land just outside the City of Greenville, state and County aforesaid, being known and designated as Lot No. 70 of Alta Vista, according to plat of same made by R. E. Dalton Engineer, June 1925 recorded in R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "G" at page 20 and having the following metes and bounds according to said plat; Beginning at a point on the north side of Oliver Street, which point is 135 feet East of the Northeastern intersection of Oliver Street with Afton Avenue, and running thence along Oliver Street, S. 85-40 E. 65 feet to a point, joint Southern corner of lots nos. 69 and 70; running thence along joint line of said lots, N. 4-15 E. 189.3 feet to a point, joint Northern corner of lots nos. 69 and 70; running thence along rear line of lot no. 70, N. 85-45 W. 65 feet to a point, joint Northern corner of lots nos. 70 and 71; running thence along joint line of said lots, S. 4-15 W. 189.1 feet to the beginning point.
