

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN:

I, George W. Balentine, of Greenville County, South Carolina, SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS I the said George W. Balentine

in and by my certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, am well and truly indebted to FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of TWENTY-SIX HUNDRED, TWENTY-FIVE & NO/100 (\$ 2625.00) Dollars,

with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of THIRTY & NO/100

(\$ 30.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid; said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I the said George W. Balentine

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me the said George W. Balentine

in hand well and truly paid by the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "D" at Page 268, and having according to said plat, the following metes and bounds, to-wit:

Beginning at an iron pin on the north side of Easley and Greenville Highway, joint corner of Lots Nos. 2 and 3, and running thence with the line of Lot No. 3, N 16-15 W. 148.7 feet to a stake in line of Lot No. 4; thence with the line of Lot No. 4, N 73-45 E. 62.5 feet to a stake; joint corner of Lots Nos. 1 and 2; thence with the line of Lot No. 1 S. 16-15 E. 147.6 feet to an iron pin on Easley and Greenville Highway; thence with the northern side of said Highway, S. 72-28 W. 62.5 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to George W. Balentine by Mabel W. White, et al., by deed dated September 21, 1937, and recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Book of Deeds "200" at Page 84.
