All that certain tract of land, in Grove Township, Greenville County, State of South Carolina, containing Forty-five and 32/100 (45.32) acres, more or less, Bounded on the North by J. M. Riddle J. C. James, on the East by Fork Shoals Road, on the South by John Ashmore and Elvie R. Burns, and on the West by E. E. Ashmore, said tract being specifically described by metes and bounds, according to a plat made by W. J. Riddle, Surveyor, November 14, 1938, now on file with The Federal Land Bank of Columbia, as follows:
