

MORTGAGE OF REAL ESTATE

TO ALL WHOM THESE PRESENTS MAY CONCERN: I, C. L. Steadman, of Greenville, S. C. SEND GREETING:

WHEREAS, I, the said C. L. Steadman

in and by MY certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents am well and truly indebted to

FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, in the full and just sum of

Four Thousand, Six Hundred and No/100

(\$ 4,600.00 Dollars, with interest at the rate of (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in instalments of

FORTY -SIX AND NO/100 (\$46.00) Dollars upon the first

day of each and every calendar month hereafter in advance, until the full principal sum, with interest has been paid, said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or failure to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note, shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage, said note further providing for ten (10%) per centum attorney's fee besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind (all of which is secured under this mortgage); as in and by said note, reference being thereunto had, will more fully appear.

NOW, KNOW ALL MEN, That I, the said C. L. Steadman

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE according to the terms of said note, and also in consideration of the further sum of Three Dollars to me,

the said C. L. Steadman in hand well and truly paid by the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, at and before the signing of these presents (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged), have granted, bargained, sold and released, and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell and release unto the said FIRST FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, the following described property, to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville, and in Ward Two of the City of Greenville, and being known as Lot No. 50, of the W. C. Cleveland property, as shown on plat made by R. E. Dalton, March, 1910, and described as follows:

"BEGINNING at a point on Poinsett Avenue 182.5 feet from the northeast corner of Vannoy Street and Poinsett Avenue, and running thence N. 26-59 E. 164.5 feet to an iron pin; thence S. 84-43 E. 75 feet, 1 inch to an iron pin; thence S. 26-59 W. 192 feet to an iron pin on Poinsett avenue; thence along said avenue, N. 63-01 W. 70 feet to the beginning corner, and being the same lot conveyed to me by Julia A. Eskew by deed dated March 8, 1938 and recorded in the R.M.C. Office for Greenville County in Vol. 202, page 269."
