portion of principal or interest be at any time past due and unpaid, then the whole amount evidenced by said note to become immediately due, at the option of

the holder hereof, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for an attorney's fee of 10% of amount due

besides all costs and expense of collection, to be added to the amount due on the said note, to be collectible as a part thereof, or the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection of said debt,
