We, Luther Alexander and Pearl Alexander, of Greenville County, South Carolina SEND GREETINGS:

WHEREAS ~~X~~ We the said Luther Alexander and Pearl Alexander

in and by ~~XX~~ our certain promissory note, in writing, of even date with these presents, ~~XX~~ are well and truly indebted to FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., in the full and just sum of FOURTEEN HUNDRED & NO/100

(\$ 14.00.00) Dollars,

with interest at the rate of six (6%) per centum per annum, to be repaid in installments of FOURTEEN & NO/100

(\$ 14.00) Dollars upon the first day of each and every calendar month hereafter until the full principal sum, with interest, has been paid; said monthly payments shall be applied first to the payment of interest, computed monthly on the unpaid balance, and then to the payment of principal; said note further providing that if at any time any portion of the principal or interest due thereunder shall be past due and unpaid for a period of thirty (30) days, or fails to comply with any of the By-Laws of said Association, or any of the stipulations of this mortgage, the whole amount due under said note shall, at the option of the holder thereof, become immediately due and payable, who may sue thereon and foreclose this mortgage; said note further providing for a reasonable attorney's fee, besides all costs and expenses of collection, to be added to the amount due on said note, and to be collectible as a part thereof, if the same be placed in the hands of an attorney for collection, or if said debt, or any part thereof, be collected by an attorney, or by legal proceedings of any kind.

in consideration of the said debt and sum of money aforesaid, and for the better securing the payment thereof to the said FIDELITY FEDERAL SAVINGS AND LOAN ASSOCIATION, OF GREENVILLE, S. C., the following described property to-wit:

"All that certain piece, parcel or lot of land, with all improvements thereon, or to be constructed thereon, situate, lying and being in the State of South Carolina, County of Greenville,

in Greenville Township, at the southeast corner of Parker Road and Ohio Street, near the City of Greenville, being Lot No. 45 as shown on plat of Monaghan Annex recorded in the R. M. C. Office for Greenville County in Plat Book "C" at Page 63, and having the following metes and bounds:

Beginning at the southeast corner of Parker Road and Ohio Street, and running thence with the eastern side of Ohio Street, S. 37 1/2 W. 195 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 44; thence with the line of said lot, S. 83 1/4 E. 94 feet to a stake, corner of Lot No. 43; thence with the line of said lot in a northeasterly direction 150 feet to Parker Road; thence with the Southern side of Parker Road, N. 51-3/4 W. 48 feet to the beginning corner; being the same property conveyed to Luther Alexander and Pearl Alexander by Robert Cleveland King and Mary Irene King by deed dated May 3, 1939, and recorded in the R.
